



To the Piedmont Park Area Residents and Businesses:

Music Midtown is fast approaching, and will be held Saturday, September 16th and Sunday, September 17th, 2017. We would like to inform you of a few details in an effort to mitigate and minimize any inconveniences caused by the music festival.

- The official event hours are Saturday, September 16th from 12:00pm - 11:00pm, and Sunday, September 17th from 12:00pm - 10:00pm.
- There will be amplified sound during sound checks and performances. Sound checks begin Friday, September 15th from 5:00pm - 9:00pm, and again prior to performances on Saturday and Sunday, beginning at 9:00am.
- The following streets will be affected by lane or street closures during various times between September 8th - 21st:
  - 10th Street between Piedmont and Monroe
  - Charles Allen Drive between 10th and 8th
- The following streets will be Resident Access Only on September 16th and 17th:
  - Charles Allen Drive between 10th and 8th
  - Taft Ave between 10th and 8th
  - Argonne Ave between 10th and 8th
  - Myrtle St between 10th and 8th
  - 9th Street between Myrtle and Charles Allen Drive
  - Park Drive west of Monroe
  - Orme Circle west of Monroe
  - Elmwood Dr. west of Monroe
  - Cresthill Avenue west of Monroe
- Music Midtown will issue dash passes for your vehicles to allow quicker access into Resident Access Only streets.
- Dash passes may be obtained during the following times from the 12th Street Box Office at the Piedmont Park Community Center (next to the 12th Street entrance and Willy's Mexicana Grill, 1071 Piedmont Ave)
  - Thursday, September 14th from 12pm - 7pm
  - Friday, September 15th from 12pm - 7pm
  - Saturday, September 16th from 9am - 12pm
  - Residents affected by the Resident Access Only streets must bring (1) a valid ID, and (2) a July or August utility bill OR a recent lease agreement to confirm current residency
  - There will be a Resident-Only queue separate from the standard ticketing lines at the box office
  - Note: this is a new pickup location, as Music Midtown is not using the Grady gravel lot for ticketing.
- If you are unable to obtain a dash pass and need to access a Resident Access Only street during the two event days:
  - (1) identify yourself as a resident to the traffic officer at the barricade
  - (2) present your ID with your residential address (and a utility bill if your address is not up to date on your ID) to the traffic officer
- Note: the dash passes DO NOT provide parking; they merely grant entry through police barricades on Resident Access Only streets. All standard parking laws still apply, and fines increase to \$75 for parking in a residential parking area without a city-issued residential parking permit during special events.
- Music Midtown has allocated a set number of complimentary tickets for the neighborhood. After conferring with the Midtown Neighborhood Association, tickets will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis to:
  - Residents with a current address on 9th Street and 10th Street (must present proof of current residency during dash pass hours as above)
  - Tickets are limited to one pair of tickets per valid address until quantities run out
  - Tickets may not be re-sold
  - Tickets will be available from the Resident Dash Pass pickup line at the 12th Street Box Office at the same times as detailed above while quantities remain
- Should there be a large accumulation of attendee-related trash on your property after the event (keeping in mind most of the cleanup occurs overnight and in the morning), please call Whitten Waste Management to report the exact location of the debris: 770-439-7380.
  - This year the clean up crew will begin working from the outside (in the neighborhood) to the inside (within park)
  - Clean up crews may be cleaning in the streets overnight until roughly 3am, returning at daylight for anything previously unseen
- Music Midtown has received permission again to place portable toilets outside of the gated festival area in an effort to mitigate incidents of public urination. Public toilets will be placed in the following locations:
  - Midtown and Arts Center MARTA Stations
  - Monroe Drive near the Grady Stadium ticket booths
  - Charles Allen Drive on the Grady High School side of the street

We are grateful for your patience during this time and are looking forward to a great event.
